INDICATIONS

The Comfortland mesh shoulder immobilizer provides immobilization and support for rotator cuff injuries, shoulder instabilities, and anterior dislocations of the G-H joint. Effective in relieving strain on the shoulder by suspending the arm.

CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Hand wash in cold water with mild detergent. Allow all parts to air dry before re-assembly. Do not dry clean, iron, or bleach any part of this brace, as it could cause damage and void the manufacturer's warranty.

APPLICATION

- 1) Place arm in the shoulder sling (Fig. A), making sure the elbow fits flush in the seam of the sling, and that the hand hangs slightly out of the opening on the front of the sling (Fig. B).
- Gently bring the strap over the head, so that it rests on the opposite shoulder, and drapes across the chest (Fig. C)
- 3) Unfasten the strap from itself using the Velcro provided, and adjust so that the arm is suspended in a bent position, and little to no strain is put on the shoulder (Fig. D).
